- What products/brands do you use?
- Do you have a look/style you specialise in?
- How many different looks can I have during a trial?
- Can I take my own photos at the trial?
- Am I allowed to bring a friend for a second opinion?
- Should I bring pictures of looks/styles I'd like for myself/my bridesmaids to the trial?
- What if I don't have my veil or accessories chosen yet?
- ☐ If I change my mind about hair/makeup after the trial, is there any charge for re-trial?
- Can I wash/style/straighten my hair the day before the trial?
- Can you work with me if I have sensitive skin/scalp or allergies to certain products?
- If I'm going to tan for my wedding day, should I be tanned before the trial?
- Should I have no makeup on when arriving for trial? What about moisturiser?
- Are you available on my wedding date?
- Do I need to pay a deposit to secure the date?
